To be administered 45 minutes PRIOR to eye exam. |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> sucrose 24 % (TOOT SWEET) oral solution | 0.1 mL, oral, once PRN, mild pain (score 1-3), pain |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> proparacaine (ALCAINE) 0.5 % ophthalmic solution | 1 drop, Both Eyes, PRN, for eye exam
To be administered 30 seconds PRIOR to eye exam. |
| <input type="checkbox"/> artificial tears(hypromellose) (SYSTANE/GENTEAL) 0.3 % ophthalmic gel | 1 application, Both Eyes, PRN, dry eyes, for eye exam
To be administered for each eye exam. |
