

#### Add Commonly Used LDAs to the Avatar with Quick Buttons

#### **Key Benefits:**



Quick buttons display the two most commonly added LDAs in your department.

#### How to:

Click one of the quick buttons to create a new LDA of that type.





#### **Document LDA Information for Another Staff Member**

#### **Key Benefits:**



#### Description:

Nurses can use the **Responsible** button in the **LDA Avatar** to indicate that they documented LDA information on behalf of another nurse.

#### How to:

Click the **Responsible** button in the LDA Avatar to document the staff member who placed, assessed or removed the LDA for a patient.



# Flowsheets Filter Devices in the Data Validate Activity

#### **Key Benefits:**



#### Description:

You can now filter information in the **Data Validate** activity to focus on data from a single device. This helps when multiple devices show unvalidated data at the same time in the **Data Validate** activity.

#### How to:

Select a device from the dropdown menu in the **File Data From** field to show data from that device only.





#### **Document ICU Liberation**

#### **Key Benefits:**



#### **Description:**

The **ICU Liberation Bundle** is a set of evidence-based practices to improve patient outcomes, avoid over sedation and decrease adverse effects of sedation in the ICU.

#### How to:

- From the Flowsheet activity, Click the ABCDEF Bundle/ICU Liberation flowsheet tab.
- 2. To review or document ICU Liberation bundle information, click the ABCDEF name header in the table of contents. Document each ABCDEF bundle during multidisciplinary rounding.
  - a. Please Note: flowsheet rows



documented in other tabs of the flowsheet activity, will flow into the ICU Liberation Bundle.

Each ABCDEF Bundle title tells you what the bundle addresses in the ICU Liberation to complete documentation.

4. A read only row displays the **Target RASS Level** from the active order.



- 5. The **Target Arousal Level** also displays in Storyboard when there is an active RASS (Richmond Agitation Sedation Scale) order.
  - a. Hover to view the last filed RASS documentation from the nursing flowhseet and the Target RASS Level from the active order.

#### **Brain**



See and Filter Tasks and Medications on the Brain

#### **Key Benefits:**

#### Description:

Use the **My Discipline** and **All Disciplines** buttons to choose which tasks and medication administrations you want to see on the Brain.

- 1. Click on My Discipline to only see medication administrations for you.
- 2. Click on All Disciplines to see medication administrations by all disciplines.





#### New Icon for Dispensed/Pended or Incomplete Medications in the Brain

#### **Key Benefits:**



#### **Description:**

In the **Brain**, a new icon with a mortar, pestle and hourglass appears if all medications for that hour have a status of dispensed/pended or incomplete.

#### How to:

- Clicking the icon opens a click bubble showing more information about each medication's status.
- A smaller version of the icon appears next to each pending/dispensed or incomplete medication.



3. A text highlighted in purple indicates the medication's status.



#### It's Easier to View Different Shifts in the Brain


#### **Key Benefits:**

#### Description:

View different shifts more easily in the Brain.

- A. Use the arrows to view past or future shifts.
- B. Click the day and time span to make the calendar appear.
- C. Click to see your current shift.
- D. Click a day on the calendar to quickly switch the date.
- E. Click to switch between the shifts you're viewing for the selected day.

#### See the Most Recent Lab Results Faster


#### **Key Benefits:**

#### Description:

Lab Spotlight sections summarize the most recent lab results and components.

- 1. Search for CBC in the Search field and press Enter.
- 2. In the **Spotlight Card**, the clinician sees the patient's most recent values right away and can act on that information immediately.

#### The Event Log Gets a Boost


#### **Key Benefits:**

#### Description:

The Event Log has a new layout containing a main event pane and a sidebar for graphs and reports.

- 1. Filters you use to show or hide event types in the **Event Log** now appear in a floating panel on the left side of the screen. A **Pin** button is available to have the panel remain open.
- 2. Hover on a point in time in the graph to see more information about the data available at that time.
- 3. The Event Log now shows blood gas and vent setting information in the Event Log's main pane.
- 4. When hovering on a medication event, an enhanced hover bubble shows a snapshot of the recent administrations of that medication to the patient.



#### **Secure Chat**



#### Set Favorites in Hyperspace Secure Chat

#### **Key Benefits:**



#### **Description:**

You can now manage your favorite contacts in **Secure Chat** from a workstation. This functionality was previously only available on Epic mobile devices.

#### How to:

Use the **Star icon** to add or remove individual recipients or groups as favorites in **Secure Chat** on a workstation.





#### See More Clearly Whether a Colleague Is Available

#### **Key Benefits:**

Easily Visible in Secure Chat

#### Description:

The availability status in **Secure Chat** is easier to recognize on workstations and mobile devices. If someone is busy or unavailable, you can quickly see if you need to find someone else to contact.






#### **Automatic Secure Chat Availability Updates**


#### **Description:**

The **Care Teams** window (previously **Treatment Teams**) in **Patient Lists** has been reorganized, condensed and revamped with features that make it easier to view, edit and communicate with patients' care teams.

#### How to:

To open the **Care Teams** window, right click a patient's name from **Patient Lists**.

- 1. Use the Search field to search for team members.
- Use the Add Team Members button to add any type of team member.
- Click Chat to send a Secure Chat message to an individual team member.
- 4. Click **Chat with Team** to send a Secure Chat message to a provider team.
- 5. Use the Secure Chat icon to see a provider's current Secure Chat availability.



#### **Unit Manager**



#### Select the Columns to Print in the Unit Manager

#### **Key Benefits:**


New Workflow

#### **Description:**

When you print the **Unit Manager**, you can now choose the columns to print. Use suggested columns that match those used in **Patient Lists** printing or select custom columns.

#### How to:

The **Columns to Print** section appears when a user clicks the wrench icon next to the selected care area to print.





#### Resize Care Areas on the Unit Manager

#### **Key Benefits:**



#### **Description:**

Inpatient nurses, nurse managers, unit clerks and bed planners can now adjust the size of their care areas to see more beds or optimize spacing directly from the **Unit Manager**.

#### How to:

To resize a care area, they can hover over the space between care areas and drag the highlighted line until the care area is the desired size.



#### **Dashboards**



Wound Care Specialists Can Monitor Healing and Care with New Wound Clinic Dashboard


#### **Key Benefits:**

More Efficient

#### **Description:**

Wound care clinic managers or providers can see trends in healing rates, days to heal and risk of pressure injuries for patients with active wounds while keeping an eye on patients with consult orders.

- 1. **Wound Care Healing Rates** shows a line graph that displays the percentage of wounds that healed within 4-week, 8-week, 12-week, 16-week and 20-week intervals for a revenue location.
- 2. You can select the type of wound and revenue location you want to view.
- 3. Wound Care Days to Heal shows the average days to healing for all wounds that healed during the given time range for a revenue location.
- 4. **Wound Care Pressure Injury Incidence Rates** shows a line graph of the percentage of patients seen at a revenue location who had a hospital-acquired pressure injury.
- 5. **Patient Lists Glance** shows a clinician's My List or shared list of choice. For example, you might show a list of patients with wound consult orders.



#### Care Everywhere



Chart Search Results Load More Quickly for External Documents

#### **Key Benefits:**

Time Saver

#### Description:

To reduce the time it takes to preview very large Care Everywhere documents in **Chart Search** results, a link in the **Chart Search** hover bubble allows you to open the full document, rather than a preview, if the document exceeds the size set in the **Set partial document view** threshold field.

#### How to:

1. Click **View the full document** to open it in the document viewer.
