Patient Meal Ordering Simplified Through MyChart

Let's Eat Feature Now Available at Five HM Locations

More than 10,700 patient meals have been ordered through the **MyChart** app since the program launched at five HM locations.

With **Let's Eat**, admitted patients or their caregivers can review any dietary restrictions or limitations, review a clinician-approved menu and order a meal that complies with nutrient limits. Patients can also use the app to set delivery times and confirm their order.

"It's super easy," said one patient at HMTW.

"I like how convenient it is," said another patient at HMWB.

"It's like ordering a meal for delivery from Door Dash. I saw what was on the menu and placed the order. Wham. Bam. Thank you, ma'am," said another patient.

Let's Eat is available through the **MyChart** app on patients' personal devices or on the MyMethodist Patient iPads available in select units at five HM locations.
