

Anaphylaxis Management for Pediatric Patients [3537]

General anaphylaxis signs and symptoms such as:

- Fussiness, irritability, drowsiness, lethargy, decreased consciousness, somnolence

Cutaneous symptoms such as:

- Urticaria, pruritus, angioedema, flushing

Respiratory Compromise such as:

- Stridor, hoarseness, oropharyngeal or laryngeal edema, uvular edema, swollen lips/tongue, sneezing, rhinorrhea, upper airway obstruction, coughing, dyspnea, bronchospasm, tachypnea, respiratory arrest

Cardiovascular Collapse such as:

- Tachycardia, hypotension, dizziness, syncope, arrhythmias, diaphoresis, pallor, cyanosis, cardiac arrest

Gastrointestinal symptoms such as:

- Nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, abdominal pain
