## IV Pump Classroom Training Starts August 15

*Sign up for training in LMS now.*

IV pumps will be integrated with Epic at HMB beginning September 12. To prepare, you are required to attend classroom-based training.

If this applies to you, training has been assigned to you in LMS and you need to register for a session applicable to your role.

Classroom-based training will be held **August 15 to September 9** in the **OPC IT Training Room**. Each course is **two hours long**.
