Follow Three Easy Steps:

- 1 Send the patient by ambulance to the Emergency Department.** Houston Methodist EDs have mental health professionals available.
- 2 Call 911 if the patient refuses to go to ED.** Provide event details, the patient's location and the patient's home address, if the patient has left your clinic.
- 3 Provide the patient with the National Suicide & Crisis Lifeline. They can chat online at 988lifeline.org or call or text 988.**
